Day 1	ARRIVAL SIEM REAP (by plane, A/C car, boat)		<p>Arrive Siem Reap – Treasures of the Kingdom of Cambodia, special welcome all warmly to everybody, a moment of courtesy meeting then self-introduce with our cambodian tour guide in the meeting point's Siem Riep airport.</p> <p>Siem Riep - The Cradle of Angkor Civilization - <i>Where Cambodian were Born, this is also a famous Archaeological City</i>, as named as one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the World. Covering approx 600 sq km, it contains more than 100 fabulous ancient monuments and over dozen major compound Temples, which were built during the most splendid Era of the Khmer Dynasty between the 9th – 13th century and were the ancient capital of the Khmer Empire. The constant building program undertaken by successive Khmer kings can be compared favourably with the pyramid construction projects of the Pharaohs in Egypt. Similar to the Pharaohs, the Khmer kings made use of a vast force of slave labour. Each new "project" was made possible by the 750,000 people estimated to have lived at Angkor during the 12th and 13th centuries. Here, travellers will have experiences about Cambodian's Spirit value worth through Ancient Temples (worshipping Shiva-Hindu, or Buddha, Khmer Kings), the stately vestiges of Old Palaces, Royal Courts, ancient Terraces, Public Building, collapsed citadels and antique Towers.</p> <p>Our experienced tour guides will transmit you the most lovely aspects of Angkor Temples - <i>during 25' by coach</i> from the Airport to your luxury Hotel in the centre of town. Express check-in with welcome-drink and room-keys are being available. Take your time to free at leisure, a full resting after the long flights.</p> <p><i>Since we have not known yet your draftly flight arrive / departure on AM or PM. Day 2	SIEM REAP fullday TOUR (by A/C car)		<p>After breakfast, let's experience a fullday tour to discover Siem Riep.</p> <p>Firstly, visit Angkor Wat – one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world, as a temple and mausoleum for King Suryavarman II at the peak of the Khmer empire in the first half of 12th, Angkor Wat is probably the best-preserved of the Angkorean temples, with a central tower surrounded by four smaller towers. The central monument represents the mythical Mount Meru, the holy mountain at the centre of the universe, which was home to the Hindu God Vishnu. The whole complex covers 81 hectares, a rectangular wall measuring 1025 metres by 800 metres borders the inner edge of the moat, and temple's greatest sculptural treasure is its 2 km-long bas-reliefs around the walls...</p> <p>Continuing to the most rememberable Temples that built from 9th to 11th century such as: the Southern Entrance Gate of Angkor Thom, Bayon Temple – built by Jayavarman VII at the end of the 12th, in the exact center of the city of Angkor Thom, proceeding to Baphuon, Terrace of the Elephants & Terrace of the Leper King.</p> <p>Finally, in the late afternoon, coming to the Phnom Bakheng temple, is the first temple in Angkor region build by the YacovarmanI King in the first of 9th century, located on a slope gently hill where thousands tourist are grouping on the hilltop to catch a memorable time of life when viewing the marvellous sunset. Back to hotel. Free leisure at night. Overnight in Siem Reap. (B)</p>
Day 3	SIEM RIEP fullday tour (by A/C car)		<p>A continuing fullday tour for Angkor complex. Morning visit to Banteay Samre temple built by Suryavarman II and contains well-preserved relief depicting scenes of Vishnu and Krishna legends. Then visit Banteay Srei temple, built under Jayavarman V, as the jewel in the crown of classical Khmer arts. Its rose-coloured sandstone walls are decorated with carvings and bas-reliefs, which are among the most accomplished Angkor has to offer.</p> <p>After that, visit Kravan, Srash Srong, Ta Keo temples, is a pyramid on 5 levels whose total height is 22 metres and dedicated to Shiva, continuing to visit most rememberable Temples that build from 9th to 11th cntury such as: Preah Rup, Preah Neak Pean , Mebon Oriental, Preah Khan & especially Ta Phrom Temple, was a monastery built by Jayavarman VII as a residence for his mother. Ta Prohm has been controversially left to the destructive power of the jungle by French archeologists to show how nature can destroy man's work. It has been largely overgrown by the jungle and as you climb through the dilapidated stone structures you see many giant trees growing out of the top of the temple itself. Ta Prohm looks as many of the monuments did when European explorers first laid eyes on them. Drive to the town, stop-over for a look at Old Market & colonial quarter, take your time to enjoy a busy market day, communicating with the local sales and all sorts of their products. It's quite a sight to see, to give somewhat a picture of Cambodian social living.</p> <p>Overnight in Siem Reap (B)</p>

Day 5	SIEM REAP free at leisure - ARRIVAL IN HANOI (by plane, A/C car)		<p>After breakfast, take time to free at leisure for your independent activities until check-out at noon, continuing to free until the time transfer to Siem Reap airport for a flight to Hanoi by VN 842 at 18.00-20.00.</p> <p>Arrival in Hanoi, special welcome with cold water and wet handkerchiefs to everybody, a moment of courtesy meeting of the tour guide in the meeting point's Noi Bai Airport.</p> <p>Hanoi - its legendary beginnings from 1,010 to 15th century then before the World War II, after 1954 as well, is the cradle of Red River Delta civilization with green rice-fields, its Old streets and colonial Quarter, its calm lakes, the shaded boulevards, its verdant public parks and sunny smiles with truly Far-East Asian faces ...Our experienced tour guides will transmit you the most lovely aspects of Hanoi - the ancient city of 1,000 yrs, during 45' by coach from the Airport to your Hotel in the centre city.</p> <p>Transfer to hotel for check in and time of rest. Day 6	HANOI A fullday tour (by A/C car)		<p>After breakfast, enjoy a fullday tour of Hanoi, let's experienced the basic concepts of political Vietnam currently by visit to the Chairman Palace area, there are Ho Chi Minh mausoleum, Ba Dinh National square, Stilt House; One Pillar Pagoda, a nice group picture should photo in the parade yard of Ba Dinh National square with the great back view of Ho Chi Minh mausoleum, continuing to visit Tran Quoc Pagoda, located on an islet of West Lake, then Temple of Literature known as Vietnam's first university built on 11th century. For afternoon, visit Vietnam History Museum, to have a look at the fine collections of exhibited artefacts dating back from the time when young Vietnam keenly struggled to against the Chinese attempts at dominating this small country; then the hard struggle against the French colonists and history of the Communist Party as well, proceeding to Vietnam Fine Arts Museum to learn about Classical and Contemporary master-piece of Vietnam from thousand years.</p> <p>Followed-up by an interesting tour with traditional Pedicabs, the small rikshaws will carry you strolling around the Old Quarter and shopping streets, to relax and view to daily-life surrounding or communicating is a good way to have a full impression of the city, catch the spirit of Vietnam. Riskshaws will return back at Return-Sword Lake, to visit Ngoc Son - Heroic Temple, But Tower, where you will be fascinating with legendary stories from 600 years.</p> <p>A moment free in Garden of Hoan Kiem Lake to enjoy the lovely Hanoi landscapes in the sunset until the time of water puppet show, a unique art form of Vietnamese, at Thang Long Water Puppet Troupe, and you will also experience more about a specific culture in South-East Asia coming from an agriculture of wet rice during the performance. Day 7	HANOI - HA LONG Bay (by A/C car 175 km)		<p>After breakfast, free at leisure until check-out before noon, then drive straight up to Halong Bay, the highway is smoothly and cost you of 3.5 - 4 hours usually, since we have to stop somewhere for the rests or visiting also. Landscapes en route are very interesting with the immense rice-fields, farmers are working in the fields, small and peace villagesthere are the sweet beginnings to talk with then explanation of Vietnam by our tour guides.</p> <p>Arrival Halong Bay, check-in then take your time to free at leisure.</p> <p>(we highly recommend a strolling walk along the shore of Halong Bay while the sun is setting down, enjoy yourself the pure breeze, beautiful view of glow</p>

Day 8	HALONG BAY - HANOI - HUE (a Cruising tour by wooden junk, and A/C car 175km, plane)		<p>Early get in the bus at 06h30, breakfast in boxes will be prior placed in your luxury Junk. Transfer to the Marina for a cruising tour 5 hours by a big wooden Junk on Halong Bay, this is a golden time for your voyage - a masterpiece of Nature is dawning in the bright morning sunlight.</p> <p>Ha Long Bay is constituted by 3000 small and big islands of all shapes.</p> <p>In 1994 UNESCO classified Halong Bay as a World Natural Heritage and in November 2000, the World Heritage Committee reconfirmed this classification, your excursion to Halong Bay will re-evaluate the classification of UNESCO to this fairyland</p> <p>In the book intituled "Wonders of the World" published in 1950. The French marshal Lyautey compared it with Venice rocks in the "Letters of Tonkin and Madagascar " (June 24, 1895).</p> <p>The French novelist Yvonne Schultz did not hesitate to praise the miraculous beauty of this bay:</p> <p><i>All heights and ten thousand forms; imagination, imitation, pagodas, Hindu temples, menhirs, Chinese towers, pieces of chess-board or true immense mountain. And the extraordinary flows simulating the ruined keeps, the broken down bastions, a succession of palaces with the open belly and tribes of mutilated idols.</i></p> <p>HALONG BAY is nearly a hidden bay with thousands of limestone islands densely rising from the blue jade water in a sea area of over 1500 square kilometers. Its 1969 green islands enfeeble the strong winds blowing from the ocean to leave the transparent water of the bay often calm in cool and healthy air. From time to time, sailing Junk appearing and disappearing between the islands make the poetic sight more colorful like sparkling pearls or coral reefs found out in the bay. The beauty of the bay is not monotone, at different positions of viewing, it will astonish viewers with quite different fascinations. In the caves and grottoes of stone islands, visitors will discover and admire how many impressive stalactites and stalagmites. The caves have strange but very accurate names, have their own legends in their names as Thien Cung (Heaven Palace) grotto, Dau Go (Wooden Head) grotto, stop-over to visit the caves, your sailing Junk will continue to visit around the shapely islets of fighting cock, incense-burner and others. Landing in Titop Islet, there is the calm and so clean sand & transparent beaches, somewhat little rocky mountains and a beautiful tall terrace, enjoy sun-sea bathing there that always waits to give you the most wonderful sea bathing in calm, transparent water under the sunlight.</p> <p>Fresh sea-food (not included) is very available on board, the Junk sailing back to Marina, pick-up your luggages then drive back to Hanoi, transfer to Noi Bai Airport for a flight of VN247 at 17.20-19.00 to Hue Royal City - the Complex of Monuments, the heart of central Vietnam served as Vietnam's political capital 1802 to 1945 under the 13 emperors of the Nguyen Dynasty and was recognized as the World Cultural Heritage Site. Hue - has been the Capital of a unified Vietnam, built at about the beginning of the 19th century, combines the oriental philosophy with the traditions of Vietnam. Intimately mingled with the natural environment, the beauty and special richness of the architecture and decorative art of the building are an original image of the Vietnamese monarchy at its most prosperous period. Overnight in Hue. (B)</p>
Day 9	HUE		A fullday tour to discover Hue.

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	A Fullday tour (by A/C car, motor river-boat)		<p>Enjoy and have a look the busy market of Dong Ba, take your time to viewing, happy communicate with the jolly salesgirls who are quite well on speaking foreign languages. Here you can buy some handicrafts for souvenir, first and foremost Hue palm-leaf conical hat. Free evening for individual exploring in dreamlike Hue. Visit later the ROYAL TOMBS of Tu Duc King & Khai Dinh King, theirs serious sceneries, impressive architectures to remind a splendid monarchy. Cruising by the dragon-motor boats upstream along Perfum river, come down in the Royal Marina for visiting the Forbidden Purple City, there are The Flag Tower - a huge structure of three flat-top pyramids, the nine holy cannons are housed in two buildings beside the The Nhan and Quang Duc Miradors in the Citadel of Hue, Palace of the Supreme Harmony, was the building for great court's meetings. It faces the Noontime Gate and lies right on the central axis of the Citadel, The Mieu Temple is situated southwest of the Citadel and facing south, dedicated to ten Emperors of the Nguyen Dynasty, then The Royal Theater was the oldest of Vietnamese traditional stage that remained.</p> <p>Turn back to the Royal Marina and continuing boat upstream to visit Thien Mu Pagoda (Pagoda of Heavenly Lady).</p> <p><i>While the wind smootly moves the bamboo branches One hears the Thiên Mụ bell, and the Thọ-Xuong rooster's song.</i></p> <p>Thien Mu Pagoda located on a sloping pine hill with the front side facing the Perfume River, was firstly built in 1601 which its 21-metre-high tower of seven storeys and refined bell are always the most beautiful sceneries of the ancient pagodas in whole country, and the highest spirit of Vietnamese also, a moment enjoy the beautiful views of sunset, the sun is setting down along the Perfume river and the tinged clouds becoming dim on horizon. Let's put in your mind the sceneries surroundings...they may be a shine star of lifetime and memorable feelings. Overnight in Hue. (B)</p>
Day 10	HUE - HO CHI MINH CITY (by plane, A/C car)		<p>After breakfast, check out and transfer to Phu Bai Airport for a flight of VN251 at 09.10-10.30 to Saigon or Ho Chi Minh City, a young city with the age of more than 300 years, a center of culture, education, commerce and tourism of Vietnam, the biggest city of Vietnam mix with the West and the Orient, and once known as the "Pearl of Far East".</p> <p>Warm welcome and transfer to the city-center, stop-over to take the souvernir pictures at Neo-Roman Notre Dame Cathedral - one of the most splendid and typical of the beautiful French-built churches in Ho Chi Minh city, next Municipal Post Office - Saigon's French-style main post office to admire and take photos of its nice architecture that is one of the HO CHI MINH City's symbolizing images. Later, pass by Ho Chi Minh City People Committee (also the old French City Hall before 1975), and Municipal Theatre built in 1899.</p> <p>After check-in and a moment of resting, visit Reunification Palace – a symbol of Saigon old Government before 1975, (also called former President Palace) to learn the sorrowful historic of Vietnam Ideology War from 1954-1975, proceeding to the lacquerware / Silk factories/shops and Handmade Workshops where the skillful artisans will explain and show you the whole interesting and complicated process to produce a beautiful lacquerware from wood, egg shell, oyster shell, lacquer, and sewing, embroidering the pictures and long-dress (Ao Dai)... you will see the handicraftmen working on the products and the collections of excellent lacquerwares and Ao Dai / longdress at these Workshops too, transfer to downtown and visit to Ben Thanh Market in the heart of Saigon with how many things are available for your choice..</p> <p>Evening, we highly recommend an impress dinner cruise (not included) on</p>

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			<p>Saigon River in a floating restaurant and getting the admirable feel of the charming views of Saigon river and city-by-night during a short river-cruising. Overnight in Saigon – Ho Chi Minh City. (B)</p>
Day 11	HO CHI MINH CITY - MEKONG RIVERS (MY THO) (by A/C car 75 km, boat)		<p>After breakfast, check-out for a fantastic excursion to Mekong Rivers, overland 70 kilometers to My Tho town - the "Gateway of Mekong River and its Delta" short stopover at Cao Dai Temple in Ben Luc town, a very specific religion of countrymen in Mekong Delta which combines Buddhism, Christianity, Taoism and Confucianism, and native Vietnamese spiritualism. Mekong Delta - the rice granary of Vietnam and has vast areas of durian, mango, rambutan and other delicious tropical fruit trees.</p> <p>Arrival My Tho and transfer to the bank of Mekong River, take a motor river-boat which to be rent exclusively for the group then crossing the Upper River and cruising along Tan Long Peninsula, let's enjoy this golden moment to relax the verdant luxuriant sceneries of the watery region, taste very fresh coconut milk, disembark and visit a island, stop-over a handicraft village that produces house-hold items from materials of coconut trees. Walking on the quite country roads, you will reach to local lush orchards, taste delicious fresh fruits, drink hot tea with honey during the traditional melodies and folk music surround you. From here you can observe the life of the Mekong River Delta, the main source of rice and many other agricultural products of Vietnam. Enjoy also a short tilbury carriage tour on the village road. Take boat trip along the canal network with a bit of adventure mood in Ben Tre Province to visit a bee farm and then a coconut candy workshop. Till now rivers and artificial canals are an important circulation system of the Mekong Delta.</p> <p>On the way drive back to Saigon, stopover to visit China Town, the really typical marketplace, a good indication of the importance the Chinese have traditionally played in Vietnam's economy. Witness the bustling Binh Tay Wholesales Market where the most busiest commercial center, proceeding to visit a Chinese Lady Temple of over 150 years, with the ledendary story of the ancient boat-men refugees, contain an impress collection of Chinaware and porcelain masterpieces.</p> <p>We would highly recommend an intersting dinner (not included) in Binh Quoi tourist village, enjoy a traditional show of wedding ceremony before having dinner on the riverside restaurant with a very pleasant setting. The show will tell you the Southern Vietnamese traditional wedding with folk music and classic melodies, rites expressing Vietnamese humanity, a cup of reception herbal tea is good begining to wake-up your mind for a night show.</p> <p>Overnight in Saigon – Ho Chi Minh City. (B)</p>
